

ORDINANCE NO. 1097

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF THOMASTON, GEORGIA, TO AMEND SECTION 6-63 SUB-SECTION (a) OF CHAPTER 6 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF THOMASTON, TO PROVIDE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOL ON SUNDAYS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR LIKE PURPOSES.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Thomaston, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained by virtue of the authority thereof as follows, to-wit:

**Section 6-63 Times when sales and consumption on premises prohibited.**

Code Section 6-63 (a) of Chapter 6 of Code of Ordinances of the City of Thomaston be, and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

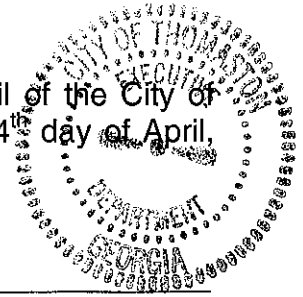
(a) It shall be unlawful to sell an alcoholic beverage within the city at any time on:

- i. Christmas Day;
- ii. between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on any day of the week; or,
- iii. on Sunday except it shall be lawful to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises from 12:30 p.m. until 12:00 midnight on Sundays and it shall be lawful for retailers of malt beverages and wine to sell package sales between the hours of 12:30 P.M. and 11:30 P.M. on Sundays.

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the terms and provisions of this ordinance be, and the same hereby are, repealed.
