The City of Thomaston is accepting applications for the position of **JOURNEY LINE WORKER** (full-time) with the Electric Department. This position has a salary range of \$43,490.55 (\$20.90 hr) - \$58,597.04 (\$28.17 hr).

**MAJOR DUTIES**

- Constructs, repairs and maintains high and low voltage electrical wiring systems and equipment, including motors, coils, transformers, meters, cross arms, lightning arrestors, insulators, traffic and street lights, test circuits, etc.
- Sets and removes utility poles.
- Maintains records and logs of repairs, maintenance and material used; maintains inventory logs.
- Responds to trouble and emergency calls related to power outages, loose or downed wires, accidents, fires, and weather-related conditions.
- Constructs, tests, and maintains electrical substations; tests and repairs airport runway beacons and director lights.
- Operates heavy equipment, including bucket or derrick trucks.
- Locates underground utilities.
- Performs other assigned duties.

**KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED BY THE POSITION**

- Knowledge of the practices, materials, tools, equipment, and safety principles used in the electrical trade.
- Knowledge of electrical construction and maintenance principles.
- Knowledge of pole line construction.
- Knowledge of safety precautions involved in working on and in proximity to energized lines.
- Knowledge of electric code requirements.
- Skill in the operation of specialized vehicles, tools and equipment.
- Skill in locating and correcting defects in electrical systems, devices, machines, and equipment.
- Skill in reading and understanding manuals.
- Skill in the operation of heavy equipment.
- Skill in oral and written communication.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

- Knowledge and level of competency commonly associated with completion of specialized training in the field of work, in addition to basic skills typically associated with a high school education.
- Experience sufficient to thoroughly understand the work of subordinate positions to be able to answer questions and resolve problems, usually associated with one to three years of experience or service.
- Possession of or ability to readily obtain a valid driver's license issued by the State of Georgia for the type of vehicle or equipment operated and possession of a motor vehicle record insurable under the city's insurance plan.
- Must successfully pass criminal and employment backgrounds and pre-employment drug screen.
- Must be able to work overtime as needed.
